Congratulations to Glebe for achieving accreditation for the SunSafe School Award. This recognition reflects our continued commitment to promoting safe and responsible behaviour in the sun and ensuring that all pupils understand how to protect themselves during outdoor activities. Throughout our Sun Safety Week, children learnt the importance of wearing sunscreen, seeking shade, staying hydrated and choosing appropriate clothing to keep themselves safe in warmer weather.

The children particularly enjoyed creating fortune-teller decision makers, which helped them rehearse key safety messages in an interactive and memorable way. They also designed their own sun-safety superheroes, allowing them to apply their knowledge creatively while reinforcing the importance of protective habits.
