First Aid Incident Notifications

Glebe have recently started to use a system called Medical Tracker to log first aid incidents in school. We will begin to send notifications to students first and second named contacts via email to notify them of any first aid incidents in school.

Please be assured that if we have any concerns over your child's health or if they sustain an injury which our first aiders feel needs medical attention, we will continue to contact parents by phone to discuss.

Important – When we start using Medical Tracker, email messages will be sent from donotreply@medicaltracker.co.uk. Please add this address to your email address books (or approved sender list) to prevent messages from being blocked by your SPAM/JUNK filters.

Absences

We have now made it possible for parents to log absences via the Arbor app.

To do this:

1. Log into your Arbor app
2. Select the 3 lines at the bottom left of the screen
3. Select 'Attendance'
4. Select 'Log Absence'
5. Input the times of absence and the reason why.
6. School will then review the reason and allocate a registration code.

Please note, if the reason is not provided then the absence will be marked as unauthorised until we can make contact with parents/carers.

You will still be able to email info@glebe.derbyshire.sch.uk or leave voicemails to notify us of absence.

Please send all absences to the school office and not to teachers through Class Dojo

If you are collecting your child early from school or have end-of-day instructions for the teacher, you can still send these to class teachers through Class Dojo. Thank you
